Introduction

This proposal is focused on filling the gap left by the demise of ActivityExchange. It does not replace ActivityExchange on a one-for-one basis but is designed to meet the needs of AIVC and member clubs. It is based on extending the current system in place for Cambridgeshire IVC.

Objectives

Allow clubs (and AIVC) to add events, allow access to the details in a secure way and share with other clubs

Architecture

Website will be hosted on its own domain e.g. ivcevents.org.uk (T.B.C.)

Support for mobile as well as desktop devices

Integrates with other mobile services e.g. maps, email, phone.

Based on industry standard technology MySQL, PHP, Bootstrap (HTML5/CSS3)

Current functionality

The following functionality is currently in use by Cambridgeshire IVC

1. Users can enter events from a secured web page.

Suggested additions/changes

If IVC were to adopt the system more widely I would propose the following changes be made. This is not exhaustive and subject to discussion, within reason, remembering that it is not the intent to add ALL functionality ActivityExchange had – just what is needed for an effective system.

AIVC would be a “club” in its own right and hence get all functionality – it is also possible specific functionality may be required which can be discussed.

1. Event sharing

As part of event entry it will be possible to share events with selected other or all clubs including AIVC

Shared events would appear in the listing of the club they are shared with and would include the name of the hosting club.

Embedding in other websites

The diary listing (basic details only) would be embeddable in any other website (using standard javascript) as per www.CambsIVC.org (see above). As above the link for details would be secured with a password which changes monthly.

Admin pages

All clubs would have an admin page

1. Login using email/password combination to admin pages.
2. Access/change to general password
3. Access to current months and next months club password
4. Change contact details
5. Make changes using main password to override

Costs

These costs are based on a flat fee paid via AIVC for the benefit of all members (currently ~3500) and include hosting, domain name and email support.

First year

£1750 which is approximately £0.50/per member

Subsequent years

As development will be far less with minor enhancements/upgrades/bug fixes this can be less

£1250 ~0.35/member

If membership/usage declines I would be open to discussion on future fees.
