

ASSOCIATION OF INTER-VARSITY CLUBS

RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT

1. VALIDITY

1.1 This agreement supersedes any previous agreement on reciprocal arrangements made between Clubs which are members of the Association of Inter-Varsity Clubs.

1.2 The provisions of this agreement apply only to fully paid-up members of a Club who are in possession of a valid membership card for that Club.

2. ATTENDANCE AT THE ACTIVITIES OF ANOTHER CLUB

2.1 A Club member who is resident in the area of another Club for any period of up to one month in any six consecutive months may use its facilities and take part in its activities provided that the member has informed the Secretary of that Club in advance.

2.2 If the period of residence is between one month and three months then the member may be asked by the Club to make good any difference in the subscription rates, or pay for the use of any facilities funded from the Club's subscription.

2.3 If the period of residence is in excess of three months then the member may be asked to apply for membership.

2.4 Whilst exercising the provisions of 2.1 and 2.2, the member shall comply with the Club's regulations and shall be afforded the same treatment as any ordinary member of that Club, except where legal considerations dictate otherwise and at a General Meeting where he may not vote.

2.5 If one Club specifically invites members of another Club or Clubs to take part in any of its activities the provisions of 2.1 and 2.3 shall not apply.

3. TRANSFER and APPLICATION for MEMBERSHIP

3.1 If a member, other than a temporary member, of a Club within the Association applies to transfer membership to another Club within the Association, the application shall be granted except that the receiving Club shall reserve the right not to accept the application in exceptional circumstances.

[This Agreement was ratified at the Association's AGM in 1978 but clause 3 was then excluded. It was restored in 1979. and amended in 2003]
